Benefactors are indispensable

Social Security income, pensions, and government aid pay only part of the cost of caring for the elderly residents. Each year the Sisters must raise over 60% of their operating costs from gifts, bequests and donated commodities. Like St. Jeanne Jugan, the Little Sisters recognize that benefactors are indispensable partners in their mission. And like her, they pray daily in gratitude for every kindness!
