Dear Families and Friends,

We hope that you all had a Happy New Year!

**Our Home continues to be in the midst of an outbreak.** The Dept of Public Health is following us and working with us through all of this. We have taken the appropriate actions, and the individuals involved are on isolation.

We are continuing to test the staff twice a week and all Residents once a week. **We are striving to maintain the wellness and safety of everyone in our Home.** We will keep you updated regarding our test results for this week.

**We are pleased to inform you that Curative Team was here this morning to administer the first vaccine of two to all Residents who consented or had their POA Consent, as well as Little Sisters and Staff.**

Due to the COVID storm and the rise of cases in Los Angeles County, **we must continue to hold off on allowing any VISITS until further notice.**

As we have explained in previous letters, **visitation is still possible only for those Residents who are compassionate cases, such as end-of life situations.** In those cases, Bing Varias, our Activities Director, will contact you to arrange a visit.

We understand that the Residents may need or desire essential items. **Please continue to assist us with picking these items up for your loved one and leaving them in a bag or box at the front door with their name on it. Our receptionists will make sure that your loved ones receive these items.**

Thank you for your understanding and collaboration as we make decisions for the health and safety of our Residents and staff. We will continue to keep you updated with any new developments.

We pray that God will protect you and your loved ones during this time.
